Rumanian is a Romance language and it is the official language of Rumania. Of the nine Romance languages, Rumanian is the only one remaining that developed from the Latin once spoken in the East Roman Empire. There are approximately 20 million speakers in Rumania, 3 million in the former USSR, 300,000 in other areas of the Balkans, and 30 thousand in the United States. There are 4 priciple dialects of Rumanian: 1) Daco-Rumanian - this is the basis for the standard dialect, 2) Aromanian / Maudo-Rumanian spoken in Greece, Yugoslavia, Albania, and Bulgaria 3) Megleno Rumanian spoken in northern Greece, and 4) Istro-Rumanian spoken in the northwest of the former Yugoslavia.

The speaker in this recording is female in her thirties from Bucarest.

Romanian Consonant Phonemes:

[r] occurs as well, but it does not contrast with the flap; it is not clear which is underlying.
