Job Description:

Under the direction of a Supervising Criminal Investigator (SCI), the Employment Development Department (EDD) Criminal Investigators (CI) detect and investigate acts of fraud committed against the California Unemployment Insurance Code (CUIC)/programs administered by the EDD, Unemployment and Disability Insurance, Paid Family Leave, etc. Prepares comprehensive reports, locate, interview, and interrogate informants, witnesses, and suspects; conduct surveillances and undercover operations. Testifies as expert witnesses for prosecutors in State and Federal courts; confer with local, State, and Federal peace officers on complex investigations. The CI provides fraud detection and awareness training to department personnel and local, State, and Federal law enforcement officers. As defined in Section 830.3 (c) of the California Penal Code, perform the full range of peace officer duties and responsibilities to accomplish assignments. Must possess a valid driver's license; travel may be required. This position is designated as a peace officer. Applicants with prior fraud investigation experience are encouraged to apply.

Special Requirements:

Background check, fingerprinting, approval of a psychological and medical evaluation required. The normal working hours for this position are 0800 hours to 1700 hours. It may be a requirement to work periods other than the normal working hours including weekends and holidays.
