"System" as an Adverb: Systematically

There are three ways of doing anything

• Randomly

You don't know how to do it. You don't care how it is done. You do it in different ways at different times. Different people do it in different ways.

• Intuitively

You know how to do it as evidenced by your performance, but you can't formulate the rules involved. You cannot teach it to others. You *know* more than you can *tell*.

• Systematically

You can articulate the steps in the process so explicitly that another entity, following your instructions, can do it and produce identical results.

Another entity: Person \rightarrow Delegation Another entity: Machine \rightarrow Automation

Systematic = Structured = Rule-Based = Programmed = Algorithmic

→ Religion → Pray
