

Blackfoot is an Algonquian language spoken by about 5000 speakers of the Blood, Peigan, and Siksika tribes in southern Alberta and Northern Montana.

Blackfoot is currently in a transitional period between what is classified by its speakers as "Old Blackfoot" and "New Blackfoot". What is presented here is a 44 year-old male Old Blackfoot Speaker from the Siksika Tribe near Calgary, Alberta.

There are no voiced non-sonorant consonants and no liquids. Stops are not aspirated, but they are released. Length is contrastive. [ç] is an allophone of /x/ that occurs near high front vowels.

Frantz (1989) reports that [h] & [?] are contrastive in Blackfoot, however neither are exhibited in this speaker. At the time of the recording of the New Blackfoot speaker it was thought that the loss of these sounds was characteristic of the New Blackfoot, but that does not seem to be the case. Another possible explanation is a dialectal difference between the Siksika Tribe (from which both recordings were taken) and the Blood Tribe (upon which Frantz's Dictionary is primarily based).

Vowel length is contrastive although it is mostly prevalent on tense vowels. Two homorganic vowels may occur sequentially. Vowel quality changes reported from the New Blackfoot recording (creaky voice, nasalization) do not seem prevalent in this speaker. Vowels are devoiced when they precede /x/.
