Abstract

The California State University is clarifying its policies to preserve the confidentiality, integrity and availability of Fresno State data and information resources. This presentation will summarize some of these policies as they apply to digital information and give methods to comply. How data is classified, how each classification of data should be handled, and what you can do now to protect data will be explored. How to comply with the standard while using cloud utilities such as Google Docs and synchronization tools like Dropbox will be discussed, as well as how some methods of data encryption may influence these services and backup routines.
